主要问题	<p>关于茂名市茂南区官渡派出所草率放任违法犯罪嫌疑人江叙的投诉</p> <p>尊敬的12389公安监督平台：</p> <p>我实名反映茂名市茂南区官渡派出所存在严重执法不当和失职行为，导致严重违法嫌疑人被草率放走，造成极坏社会影响，并怀疑其父母干部身份对案件调查产生不当干扰。</p> <p>一、案件基本事实</p> <p>茂名居民江叙，于2023年8月26日中午通过个人闲鱼及微信账号，以“领养”为借口骗取另一市民私人饲养的猫。然而与约定的“爱心领养”不同，江叙当天即将猫带回住所实施虐杀，并拍摄血腥视频。下午，江叙使用名为“mao zedong”的账号非法翻墙上传该视频至境外社交平台。视频内容不仅充斥虐杀暴力，还侮辱毛泽东主席，甚至在另一段视频中一边虐杀一边侮辱现任国家领导人。</p> <p>江叙的行为极度恶劣：</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. 长期在境外反华群组活跃，发布大量血腥视频，造成严重不良国际传播影响；</li><li>2. 多次通过闲鱼等平台骗取他人饲养的猫只，并在群组中公开炫耀从“愚蠢的”爱心人士处“骗领养”的成果；</li><li>3. 在聊天中公然侮辱国家领导人，侮辱毛泽东主席，对国家形象造成极大伤害。</li></ol> <p>二、公安机关草率处置及疑似干扰</p> <p>8月29日，江叙被带至昆明市官渡派出所。但派出所并未依法调查取证，而是因其单方面声称“患有抑郁症”即将其释放。该做法严重违法规定：</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· 《刑法》第十八条明确：精神障碍免责须经省级指定司法鉴定机构确认在作案时完全丧失辨认或控制能力。</li><li>· 抑郁症一般不影响认知与控制能力，江叙在骗领养、规避身份、威胁他人等行中逻辑清晰，主观故意明显。</li><li>· 官渡派出所未依法启动司法鉴定，仅凭口头陈述即放人，明显失职。</li></ul> <p>更令人担忧的是，江叙父母均为广东茂名市农行系统干部。结合此前有关注此事的市民因善意咨询监督派出所调查情况反被禁言施压的情况，社会上普遍怀疑江叙父母动用关系对案件调查产生不当干扰，导致官渡派出所作出异常宽纵的处理。若情况属实，已严重损害公安机关公信力。</p>

In the digital age, where compassion can connect across continents, so too can depravity find a dark corner to fester. The case of Jiang Xu, a young man from Maoming, Guangdong Province, is not merely a story of animal abuse. It is a horrifying tapestry woven with threads of calculated deception, extreme sadism, the weaponization of social media, and most alarmingly, a blatant failure of local justice that suggests impunity for the connected and the cruel. This is a story that transcends the suffering of innocent animals; it is a stark examination of a local system seemingly willing to look the other way in the face of unspeakable acts, allowing a dangerous individual to walk free while victims—both human and animal—are left without recourse.

This article details the actions of Jiang Xu, the abject failure of the Maoming authorities to uphold the law, the deeply suspicious circumstances of his release, and the urgent, global call for accountability.

## I. The Anatomy of a Predator: Jiang Xu's Methods and Crimes

Jiang Xu's actions were not impulsive acts of violence but a premeditated, systematic campaign of cruelty. His methodology reveals a sophisticated understanding of how to exploit systems of trust for malicious ends.

### A. The Deception: Grooming and Gaining Trust

The first phase of Jiang Xu's operation involved deception. He specifically targeted online communities and platforms dedicated to pet adoption and rescue. Posing as a caring, responsible individual, he would contact rescuers and pet owners who were seeking loving homes for kittens, often those they had nursed and cared for.

He employed classic grooming tactics:

- **Fabricated Persona:** He presented himself as a stable, animal-loving person, capable of providing a safe forever home.
- **Eagerness to Comply:** He would willingly agree to any terms set by the senders, including signing adoption agreements, providing personal information (often fabricated), and

paying nominal transportation fees to further legitimize his ruse.

- **Emotional Manipulation:**He expressed just the right amount of concern and affection to allay any suspicions, effectively manipulating the goodwill and vulnerability of rescuers who only wanted the best for the animals in their care.

This calculated deceit was the critical first step, allowing him to acquire living, feeling beings not as companions, but as commodities for torture.

## B. The Atrocities: A Catalogue of Sadistic Violence

Once the animals were in his possession, Jiang Xu's true nature was revealed. The descriptions of his actions, corroborated by evidence he himself created, are nothing short of monstrous. They point to a level of cruelty that is pathological and deeply alarming from a public safety perspective.

His toolkit and methods read like a horror novel:

1. **502 Glue and Boiling Water:**In one of his most vile acts, Jiang Xu used strong adhesive glue to stick helpless kittens together. He then poured boiling water over them. The combination of the scalding water and the violent tearing apart of their glued bodies would have inflicted unimaginable, prolonged agony before death.
2. **The "Pig Herder" Electrocuting Device:**Sourcing tools from the dark underbelly of the internet, Jiang used a high-voltage electric shocking device, colloquially known in abusive circles as a "pig herder." This instrument is designed to control large livestock through painful electric shocks. Its use on tiny kittens is an act of extreme, overpowering brutality, delivering excruciating pain and causing cardiac arrest.
3. **The Butcher's Cleaver and Meat Cleaver:**Jiang Xu employed large blades, including a traditional Chinese 铡刀 (zhádāo) – a cleaver used for chopping through bone and tough meat. He used these instruments to perform dismemberments, decapitations, and live bisections (腰斩, a historically brutal form of execution) on fully conscious animals.
4. **The Kitchen Knife:**In acts of frenzied violence, he used common kitchen knives to chop and mince kittens "like meat paste," as described by those who have seen the evidence, demonstrating a complete desensitization to life and suffering.

## C. The Motivation: Narcissism, Community, and Political Provocation

Perhaps most chilling is Jiang Xu's motivation. He was not a solitary actor hiding his crimes. He was a performer seeking an audience.

- **Documentation and Dissemination:**He meticulously filmed and photographed his torture sessions. This was not for private consumption but for public distribution within dedicated encrypted groups on platforms like Telegram.
- **Seeking Validation:**By sharing these videos, he sought validation and status within a community of like-minded individuals. This transforms the act from one of private sadism into a public performance of cruelty, a perverted form of social bonding based on shared deviance.
- **Political Smear and Mockery:**In a calculated move to further insulate himself and provoke a response, Jiang Xu coupled his videos with vile insults directed towards China's national

leaders. Furthermore, he openly mocked and taunted the rescuers he had deceived, laughing at their grief and naivety. This serves a dual purpose: it aligns him with anti-state rhetoric (perhaps hoping it would grant him protection in certain circles) and adds an additional layer of humiliation to his victims.

## II. The Systemic Failure: The "Maoming Cap" and the Mysterious Release

The discovery of Jiang Xu's actions sparked rightful public outrage. Evidence was compiled, and reports were filed. For a brief moment, it seemed justice might be served. In late August 2025, it was reported that Jiang Xu was taken in by the Maoming Public Security Bureau for questioning.

However, this hope was swiftly extinguished. **Within a day, Jiang Xu was released back onto the streets.**

The official reason, filtered through information channels, is as suspicious as it is convenient: he was released on the grounds of possessing a **"mental illness" certificate**. This development raises profound and disturbing questions about the integrity of the local Maoming authorities, colloquially referred to as the "Maoming cap" (茂名帽子, Maoming màozi).

### A. The "Mental Illness" Canard: A Textbook Strategy

The use of a mental health diagnosis to evade criminal responsibility is a well-worn tactic for the powerful and connected in China. In this case, its application is transparently dubious.

- **Premeditation vs. Psychosis:** Mental illnesses that could explain such violence are typically characterized by a break from reality, delusions, or a lack of impulse control. Jiang Xu's actions display the opposite: **highly premeditated planning** (the deception, acquiring tools), **meticulous execution** (filming), and **clear, calculated intent** (sharing for social credit). This is the profile of an antisocial personality disorder (sociopathy) at best, and sadism at worst, conditions which are rarely successful as insanity defenses in legal systems worldwide, as the individual is usually aware their actions are wrong.
- **The Speed of the Diagnosis:** Reputable psychiatric evaluation for criminal responsibility is a complex, lengthy process involving multiple experts and observations. The fact that a definitive diagnosis and legal certification was produced virtually overnight is medically implausible and points to one thing: **interference and fabrication.**

### B. The Role of Jiang Zhi Hui: Allegations of Corruption and Influence

The swift and bizarre release immediately points to the potential influence of Jiang Xu's father, **Jiang Zhi Hui** (江智慧), identified as a cadre at the **Agricultural Bank of China's Maoming Branch.**

The allegations are serious and specific: that Jiang Zhi Hui used his position, connections, and influence within Maoming to orchestrate the creation of a false mental health certificate, thereby short-circuiting the judicial process and securing his son's release. This constitutes a severe abuse of power and a blatant attempt to pervert the course of justice.

If true, this is not merely parental protection; it is an act of corruption. It suggests that within Maoming, the connections of a mid-level banking official can be leveraged to override law enforcement procedures, making a mockery of China's professed nationwide campaign against corruption and for rule of law.

### C. The "Maoming Cap": Complicit in Corruption?

The Maoming Public Security Bureau's role in this is deeply suspect. By accepting this flimsy excuse and releasing a individual who had just days before been publicly exposed for heinous crimes, they have effectively:

- **Failed the Victims:**The rescuers, one of whom is reported to have suffered a severe depressive breakdown due to the trauma of being deceived and the fate of the animal they tried to save, have been denied justice.
- **Endangered the Public:**Numerous psychological studies worldwide have established a clear and undeniable link between cruelty to animals and future violence against humans. Jiang Xu is not a reformed individual; he is a proven, sadistic predator who has been empowered by the system's failure to hold him accountable. His release is a clear and present danger to the community of Maoming.
- **Damaged China's International Reputation:**Cases like these, when covered internationally, are seized upon to paint a picture of a lawless, corrupt, and brutal China. The government's own stance on "socialist core values" and a "Harmonious Society" is undermined by such blatant local failures.

### III. The Legal Basis for Prosecution: Why His Release is an Outrage

The claim that there are "no laws" against this in China is a convenient falsehood used to justify inaction. While China lacks a comprehensive national anti-animal cruelty law, several existing legal instruments could and should be applied.

1. **Public Order Laws: "Creating Disturbances" (寻衅滋事罪):**This is the most applicable charge. Article 26 of China's *Public Security Administration Punishment Law* provides for the detention of individuals who "disturb public order." The widespread social revulsion, the public dissemination of extremely disturbing content, and the act of deceiving multiple citizens unequivocally meet the standard of disrupting social harmony. This alone is grounds for significant administrative detention.
2. **Destruction of Property (故意毁坏财物罪):**Under Article 275 of the *Criminal Law*, intentionally destroying public or private property can lead to criminal charges. Pets are legally considered property. Their monetary value can be established through adoption fees, veterinary costs, and market value. A concerted effort by victims could easily push the collective value of the animals he destroyed past the threshold for criminal prosecution.
3. **Violations of Cyber Security and Public Morality:**Distributing extreme, violent, and gory content online is illegal under China's strict cyber laws. His videos are not just animal abuse; they are illegal media content that "spreads terror" and violates laws against distributing violent and bloody information.

The tools for prosecution exist. The Maoming authorities' refusal to use them is a deliberate choice, not a legal necessity.


### **Conclusion: A Call for Action and Accountability**

The release of Jiang Xu is a stain on the city of Maoming and a betrayal of the Chinese people's trust in their legal system. It signals that connections can trump justice and that unimaginable cruelty will be met with a shrug if the perpetrator has the right *guanxi*.

Therefore, the call for action must extend beyond Maoming:

- **To the National Supervisory Commission and the Central Commission for Discipline Inspection (CCDI):**A full investigation must be launched into Jiang Zhi Hui for alleged abuse of power and corruption. The process by which Jiang Xu obtained his mental health certification must be scrutinized, and any officials found to be complicit must be punished.
- **To the Guangdong Provincial Public Security Department:**They must overturn the Maoming bureau's erroneous decision, take over the case, and re-arrest Jiang Xu. He must be charged to the fullest extent of the law, and a genuine, independent psychiatric evaluation must be conducted.
- **To the Agricultural Bank of China's Head Office:**They must launch an internal investigation into their employee, Jiang Zhi Hui, for conduct utterly unbecoming of a state-bank cadre and for bringing the bank into serious disrepute.
- **To the International Community:**Continuous awareness and diplomatic inquiries are necessary. Pressure must be applied to ensure that China lives up to its own laws and international expectations regarding animal welfare and judicial integrity.

Jiang Xu's actions revealed a deeply disturbed individual. The Maoming authorities' response revealed a deeply corrupted local power structure. Justice for the kittens and the humans who loved them cannot be found in a Maoming police station. It must now be demanded from higher authorities in Guangzhou and Beijing. The world is watching to see if the Chinese system is capable of self-correction, or if the "Maoming cap" will forever symbolize a shelter for cruelty and corruption.
